Municipal Lots

Municipal lots located at Broad St (F Lot), West Milton Ave. (H Lot) and Fulton St (Mango's) are available to the public free of charge during evening hours (7pm-5am) and on weekends.

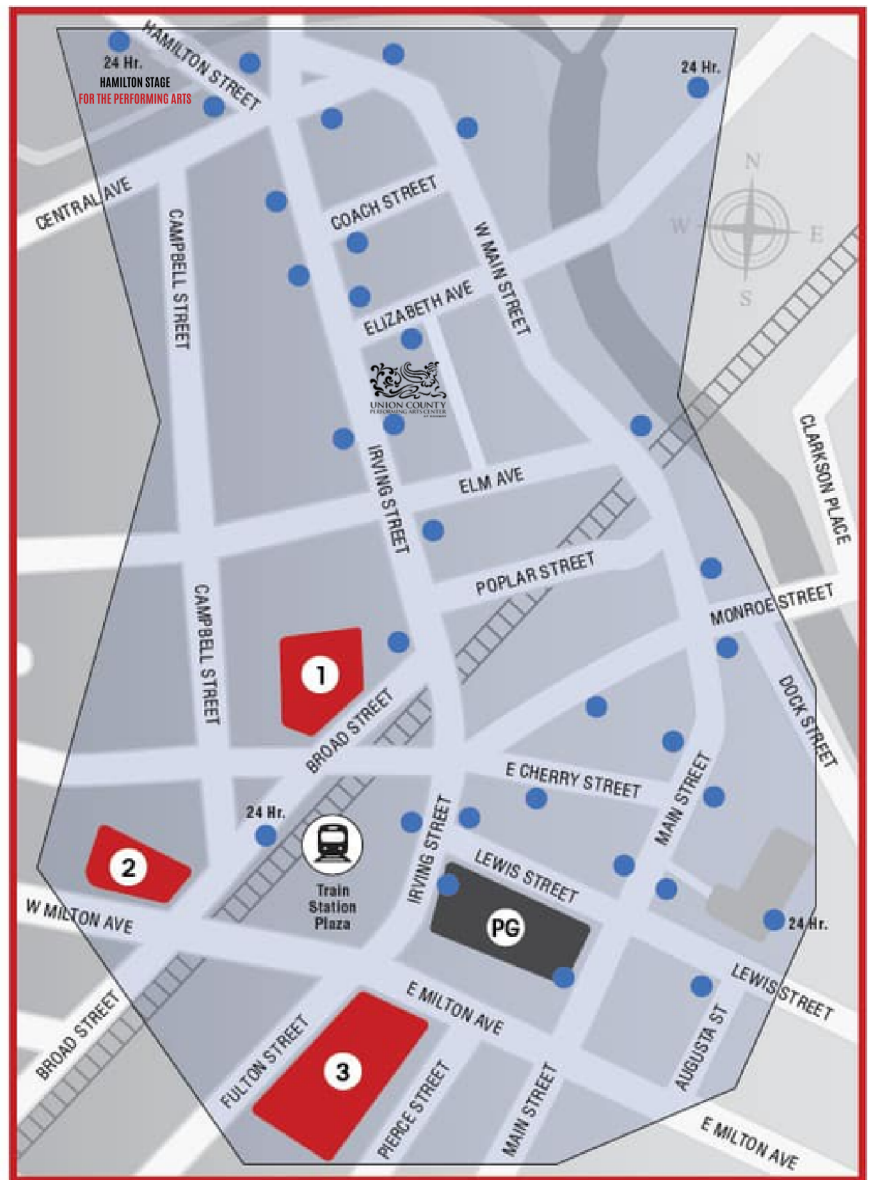
Rahway Parking Garage

At all times, the first 30 minutes is free. Extended free parking is available for the first two hours of parking on the following days and times:

- Monday through Thursday after 5pm and until 12am.
- Friday from 5pm-1am.
- Saturday and Sunday from 11am-1am.

Pay Station Parking

- The first half hour is free after inputting license plate number into pay station accordingly.
- Follow prompts on the pay station screen.
- Download the Flowbird app for convenient meter payments directly from your cell phone
- 4 hour parking maximum.
- River Place pay station is designated for River Place parking ONLY.



PARKING | Frequently Asked Questions

How do I access pay stations for on-street parking?

There are 29 modern pay stations located downtown. The first 30 minutes are complimentary; however, users MUST still input their license plate and information into the pay stations to register for the free 30 minutes. These pay stations accept coins or credit/debit card payments.

Can I pay by phone for on-street meter parking?

Yes. Payment can also be made using the Flowbird Parking app. In all cases, payment is made by license plate number, with no need to remember space numbers or go to a specific pay station.

When is meter parking in effect?

Metered on-street parking will be in effect from 7 am to 7 pm, Monday through Saturday. The rate is \$1 per hour, with a maximum of four hours. The minimum amount of time is 15 minutes (\$0.25) if paying by coin or 60 minutes (\$1) if paying by card or app. On-street parking will be free at all other times.

Where are dual-purpose surface lots located?

Three of the City's municipal parking lots have long been reserved for those holding commuter permits. These include the lot on Broad Street ("F Lot"), West Milton Avenue ("H Lot"), and Fulton Street ("Mango's"). However, during evening hours and weekends, these lots often sit empty. To help optimize the use of these lots, they have been converted to "dual-use." While they will continue to be used for commuter permit parking from 5am to 7pm, Monday to Friday, they will be available to the public free of charge 7pm-5am and from Friday 7pm to Monday 5am.

I'm going to pick up a takeout order. Do I have to pay for parking?

The City of Rahway has implemented 15-minute parking spaces for food pick-up convenience throughout the downtown. These spaces are marked with a red 15-minute parking sign. In addition, all metered spaces offer the first 30 minutes free, but a plate number must be entered.

Where can I obtain a Monthly Parking Permit for the Parking Garage or municipal lots?

How can I tell if the Parking Garage has available parking spots?

Located above the entrance to the parking garage on Main St., there is a digital signboard that displays the number of available parking spaces within the garage.

Does the Parking Garage have any free parking times?

At all times, the first 30 minutes is free. Extended free parking is available for the first two hours of parking on the following days and times:

- Monday through Thursday after 5pm and until 12am.
- Friday from 5pm-1am.
- Saturday and Sunday from 11am-1am.
